

Parkview Neighborhood Association Summer Board Meeting: June 11, 2013 1467 Moss Street

- The Board deferred discussion and approval of minutes from the Spring board meeting and a resolution regarding the requirement of 2 signatures on PNA checks (president and treasurer).
- Jean delivered the treasurer's report for Deena, who was absent. Cash on hand is \$3,545.44
- The meeting then proceeded with a presentation from Mid-City Volleyball Group (MCVG). MCVG seeks to establish a quasi-permanent volleyball complex at the corner of Orleans and N. Jeff Davis Parkway in green space adjacent to Bayou St. John.
- Susan Lavie presented MCVG's mission and plan. MCVG also presented architectural drawings of the planned facility.
- It was noted that the Sewerage and Water Board (SWB) would be the lessor of the proposed volleyball complex space and SWB would make a decision about whether to enter into a lease with MCVG at an upcoming meeting.
- PNA Board members and guests were provided an opportunity to ask questions of MCVG. There were several discussions concerning: quality of life issues, the petition of support conducted by MCVG; and the permitting process from the city that were left unanswered.*
- Following the roundtable question and answer session, PNA thanked MCVG for their presentation and MCVG members left.
- The PNA board agreed to establish a committee to address possible provisos in order to determine whether PNA could support MCVG with the S&WB: Cici, Jillian, Brian and Andy agreed to serve on the committee to explore potential points of agreement and dispute.
- The board agreed that June 29 would be the Summer meeting date.
- Jean agreed to host the Summer meeting at her house with a crawfish boil and membership drive with specific details and costs TBD. The board voiced unanimous support for the idea and budget. John Bankston offered some advice regarding supplies and set-up.
- Following discussion of the crawfish boil, and the hour turning late, members thanked Barbara for hosting the event and the meeting was adjourned.
