MCS D promotes safety and security in our community! It provides:

- 24/7 Security Patrols
 - Officers assigned to MCS D are fully commissioned by NOPD.
 - Patrols are conducted 24/7 within the MCS D boundaries
 - Patrolling vehicles are visibly marked by NOPD and MCS D logos.
- Additional Police Patrols
 - MCS D also acts as additional units to NOPD 9-1-1 calls for service in the District.
 - This helps reduce 9-1-1 response time and provides critical and timely support in Code 2 emergencies in the District.
- Cell Phone access to patrols for District residents 504 252 1570
 - MCS D officers respond to incoming phone calls from Mid-City residents between 7:00 PM-3:00 AM daily.
 - Calls outside of those hours are usually responded to the next day.
 - *****NOTE:** dial 9-1-1 in cases of emergency and other police matters.
- MCS D Security Escort
 - To facilitate the safety of Mid Citizens arriving at their homes or leaving their businesses during the above hours, a request can be made for a MCS D officer to meet them at their respective homes or businesses. 504 252 1570
 - A phone number, name and address must be registered with MCS D in order to qualify for this service. You can register on the web site at the top of this page.
 - Please allow officers a reasonable amount of time to respond. 10 to 15 minutes is suggested as they may be on a 9-1-1 call for service.
- Other initiatives
 - Security lights in areas of high volume of calls for service and no city street lights present.
 - MCS D has funded a security camera program through MCNO. Contact them at camera@mcno.org
 - The MCS D Commissioners are available to answer any questions about the District. Email them at the email address above.
 - The website posts: monthly crime trends in the District; weekly District crime maps; financial information; a registration tab for the cell number; Board meeting agenda and minutes; numbers to city services; and other information.
